



MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT for STUDENT EXCHANGE

Between

YILDIZ TECHNICAL UNIVERSITY, TÜRKİYE

and

OSAKA METROPOLITAN UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

In consideration of the Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as “MoU”) between Yildiz Technical University (hereinafter referred to as “YTU”) and Osaka Metropolitan University (hereinafter referred to as “OMU”), a Memorandum of Agreement (hereinafter referred to as “MoA”) for Student Exchange between YTU and OMU has been decided with the following stipulations:

ARTICLE 1 - MAGNITUDE AND DURATION OF EXCHANGES

- (1) The number of outgoing exchange students from each institution is limited to two (2) per year. However, this number may be changed for any given year upon the consent of both universities.
- (2) The period of study at the host university is limited to one (1) year.

ARTICLE 2 - ELIGIBILITY

- (1) The home university will select the appropriate student(s) to attend the host university. Final acceptance is ratified by the host university.
- (2) The status of the student at the host university will be a non-degree exchange student.
- (3) The exchange student must possess a sufficient level of linguistic ability to attend the courses at the host university.

ARTICLE 3 - CREDITS

Upon completion of courses, the host university will provide the exchange student with an academic record of completed courses, which the exchange student may use to obtain credits at the home university, subject to the rules and regulations of the home university.



ARTICLE 4 – TUITION AND OTHER EXPENSES

- (1) The exchange student will pay the tuition and any other fees of the home university and will not be charged an entrance examination fee, admission fee, or tuition fee by the host university.
- (2) The exchange student will be individually responsible for all other expenses, such as travel costs, accommodation, food, study materials, transportation, insurance, medical costs, personal expenses, and fees related to visa applications.

ARTICLE 5 – SUPPORT

- (1) Both universities will do their best to assist the exchange student in obtaining a visa and finding suitable accommodation. The exchange student will be able to use the university facilities, such as library.
- (2) Both universities will do their best to involve the exchange student in academic life at the host university.

ARTICLE 6 – INSURANCE

Before leaving their home country, exchange students must purchase travel insurance to cover the duration of their stay abroad.


ARTICLE 7 - DISMISSAL

The host institution reserves the right to dismiss any participating student at any time for academic or personal misconduct. The dismissal of a participant shall not abrogate the memorandum for the arrangements regarding other participants.

ARTICLE 8 – DURATION, AMENDMENT, AND TERMINATION OF THIS MEMORANDUM


